Second Sunday of Lent





Praised be Jesus Christ! Last week, Jesus showed us how to get through the testing of the forty days and nights of Lent, with fasting, almsgiving and prayer. This week, Jesus shows His disciples what it's all for, what is really going on: our transformation in glory. The Holy Spirit leads us through these days and is transfiguring/transforming us in glory. Hold on for the ride.

We were all very saddened on Monday to learn that Father Norman Thomas, pastor of Sacred Heart (since 1968) and of St. Elizabeth's (2007), passed away during the night. There will be visitation at Sacred Heart this week on Thursday and Friday from 9 until 9. The funeral Mass will be on Saturday. In order to be good family members to the parishioners of Sacred Heart and St. Elizabeth, we will offer our Masses for Father Thomas at our parishes (St. Augustine/St. Monica on Wednesday, Nativity on Thursday and St. Charles on Friday). We want to free up seats for the Sacred Heart and St. Elizabeth parishioners for the funeral Mass on Saturday. Eternal rest grant unto him O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon him.

Our deacons have also been a great support and have been showing how service is done best. The Capuchins and Jesuits called and offered their service in our parishes in the weeks ahead. As religious, they have stepped up and have let us know we can count on them. We are truly blessed.



**Archbishop Vigneron's statement on Pope Francis' Global Rules for Reporting Abuse**

A new papal law requiring priests and religious to report sexual abuse and misconduct provides "clear directives for universal accountability in response to the horrors of clergy sexual abuse," Archbishop Vigneron has told Detroit Catholic. The law provides whistleblower protections for anyone making a report and requires all dioceses to have a system in place to receive the claims confidentially. And it outlines internal procedures for conducting preliminary investigations when the accused is a bishop, cardinal or religious superior. "I am deeply sorry to all those who have been injured and are enduring a lifetime of physical, emotional and spiritual suffering because of perverse actions by those in authority," the archbishop said. "No one is above civil law, and importantly, no one is above God's law." Pope Francis announced the new norms. The Archdiocese of Detroit encourages individuals to report clergy sexual abuse of minors and others directly to law enforcement – no matter when the abuse occurred. The Michigan Attorney General's Office has established a toll-free reporting hotline at (844- 324-3374, Monday through Friday, 8 am to 5pm. [aginvestigations@michigan.gov](mailto:aginvestigations@michigan.gov)). Individuals also may contact their local police department. For complaints involving priests, deacons, religious, or laity, individuals are welcomed to contact the Archdiocese of Detroit's Victim Assistance Coordinator at (866) 343-8055 or [vac@aod.org](mailto:vac@aod.org).


