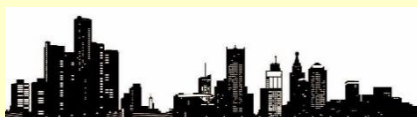

## **St. Charles Mission Statement**

St. Charles Borromeo, a diverse urban parish of Detroit, is rooted in Christ's Gospel and Catholic tradition. We strive to build a community of faith through education, worship, and evangelization. **Parish Family Mass schedule.** Daily Mass is a wonderful way of staying in union with Christ. I strongly suggest you try it for two weeks and then see what you see for yourself. In our family, Mass is offered on Tuesdays at Sacred Heart at 5 PM, on Wednesdays at St. Augustine and St. Monica parish at 9am, on Thursdays at 11am at Nativity (beginning next week at 9 AM), and Fridays at St. Charles at 11am.

**Upcoming Holy Hours.** Beginning **the week June 12th**, we will have Holy Hours on **Wednesdays at 8am at St. Augustine/St. Monica**, on **Thursdays at Nativity at 8am** and at **St. Charles on Fridays at 8am**. The Thursday Holy Hour will begin with a 7-minute teaching from the Desert Fathers on how to pray and act as a follower of Jesus. The Friday Holy Hours will begin with Morning Prayer. We will also have the **8:15pm Holy Hour at St. Augustine/St. Monica** on Thursday evening.

### **The Descent of the Holy Spirit**

On Pentecost, the Holy Spirit descended on the apostles, “with a sound from heaven, as of a violent wind blowing.” Often, when the Holy Spirit comes to us, it is quietly. During the Mass, the Holy Spirit is invoked over the congregation and over the bread and wine.

At Mass, the consecration bells have been rung at St. Charles in the past years when the Word of God come upon the bread and wine and change them. It is also a permitted custom to ring them at the epiclesis, the time when the Holy Spirit is invoked on the bread and wine. The Word of God and the Spirit of God, sent by the One Jesus called “Father” change us and they change the bread and wine.

To highlight the presence and action of the Holy Spirit at Mass and in our lives, we will start ringing the consecration bells at the time the Holy Spirit comes upon the gifts.

These days, the Gospel preached to us is about the Holy Spirit and about the Most Holy Trinity, let’s open our lives to the Living God and thank God for the love poured out on us.

### Stewardship Minute:

#### Positive Stewardship

*"The Advocate, the Holy Spirit whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything and remind you of all that I told you." (JOHN 14:26)*

The materialism of our society lures us to concentrate more on what we want than on what God wants for us. The relativism of our world tells us that we should be tolerant of all things, that there is no absolute truth.

As **Stewards** we should pray to the Holy Spirit to transform our lives and to guide our thoughts, words and actions. What you put in your head, heart and mind affects your actions. Put good things in and good things will come out.

### Archbishop Vigneron's statement on Pope Francis' Global Rules for Reporting Abuse:

A new papal law requiring priests and religious to report sexual abuse and misconduct provides "clear directives for universal accountability in response to the horrors of clergy sexual abuse," Archbishop Vigneron has told Detroit Catholic. The law provides whistleblower protections for anyone making a report and requires all dioceses to have a system in place to receive the claims confidentially. And it outlines internal procedures for conducting preliminary investigations when the accused is a bishop, cardinal or religious superior. "I am deeply sorry to all those who have been injured and are enduring a lifetime of physical, emotional and spiritual suffering because of perverse actions by those in authority," the archbishop said. "No one is above civil law, and importantly, no one is above God's law." Pope Francis announced the new norms. See [detroitcatholic.com](https://detroitcatholic.com) to learn more. 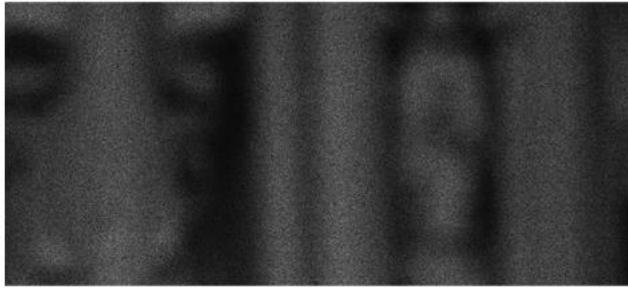

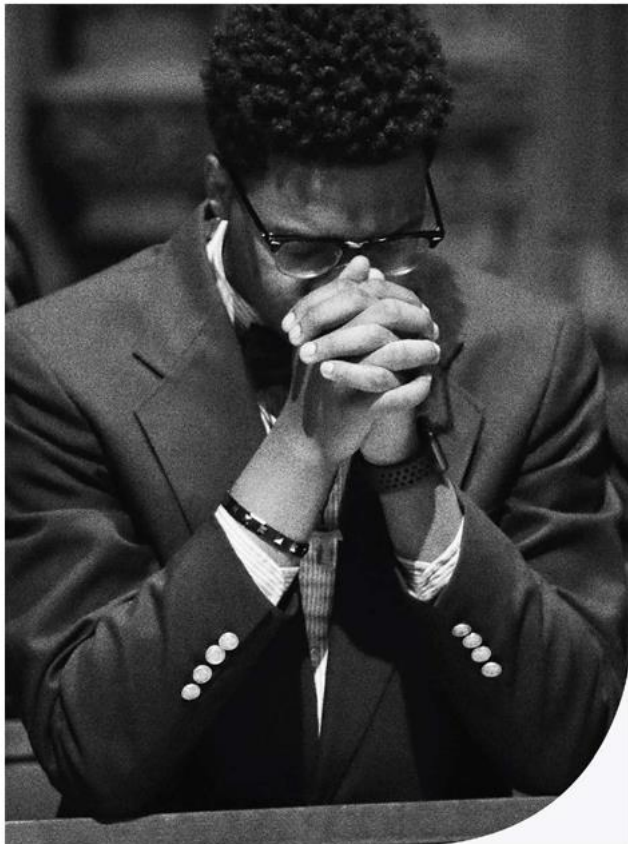

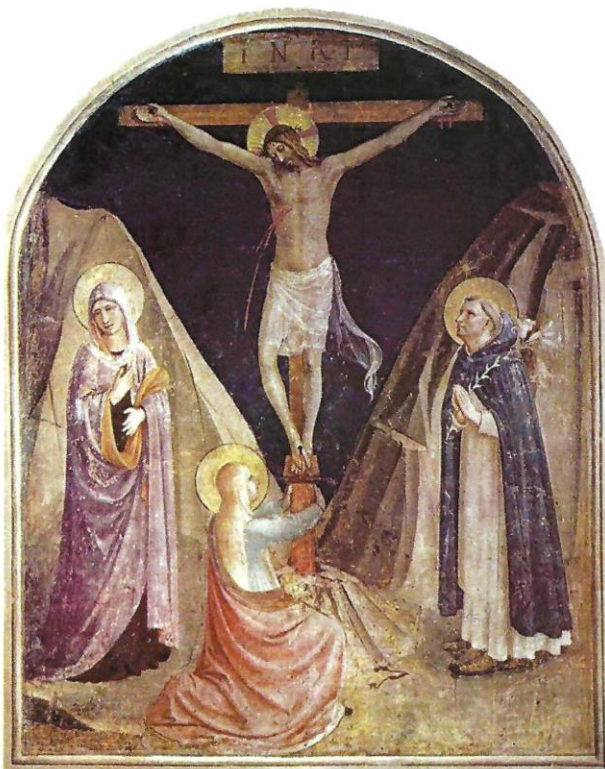
